

Heavy Haul Planning Checklist

Ten checks for your hauling operation

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Work through these across the year, not in April.
Check the weight rating before the class.

☐ **1 Weight ratings checked**
Class 16 at 40 percent where they qualify.

☐ **2 No tractor in 10.1**
That is a passenger vehicle class.

☐ **3 Trailers and rigging split**
Class 10 for decks, Class 8 for rigging.

☐ **4 Pilot cars separated**
The passenger cars can apply to those.

☐ **5 Claims dated properly**
Available for use, after certification.

☐ **6 Recapture modelled**
Before trading units, not on the return.

☐ **7 Driver meals at 80%**
Eligible long-haul trips, not the general 50.

☐ **8 Trip logs kept**
Period, distance and destination recorded.

☐ **9 Freight tax settled**
Interprovincial is domestic, not an export.

☐ **10 Interlining agreed**
Which carrier invoices the shipper.

PRO TIP

A tractor is not a passenger vehicle.
Check the weight rating, then the class.

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
